

FUGE Camps Glossary of Terms & Lingo

Centrifuge	Centrifuge is a camp brand offered at FUGE Camps. By registering your group for Centrifuge, your students will be divided into groups for recreation and Bible Study based on age by grade most recently completed. Check out www.fugecamps.com/centrifuge for more information!
MFuge	MFuge is a camp brand offered at FUGE Camps. By registering your group for MFuge, your students will participate in hands on ministry experiences by serving the needs of the local community. Your students will be divided into groups based on the work they request to do. Check out www.fugecamps.com/MFuge for more information!
Bible Study Leader	What we call our FUGE Camps staffers who lead Centrifuge Bible Study.
Ministry Track Leader	What we call our FUGE Camps staffers who lead MFuge Bible Study.
Opening Celebration	Opening Celebration is the very first collective gathering that students and group leaders will encounter on the day you arrive at camp. You can expect a big welcome, fun videos, hype songs led by the band and lots of excited FUGE Camps staffers eager to meet you and your group! This will be held in the auditorium.
Morning Celebration	Morning Celebration is the first event that starts each full day of camp. You can expect FUGE Camps staffers to be dancing, getting your students excited for the day, and for fun games hosted by our emcee! The band will play and the camp pastor will introduce the daily theme.
Closing Celebration	Closing Celebration happens on the day you and your group depart from camp and will be the last thing on your schedule that we get to share together before you go home. During Closing Celebration, you will receive an encouraging word from the camp pastor and bittersweet goodbyes from your FUGE Camps staff.

<p>Recreation or “Rec”</p>	<p>Recreation or “rec” is a staple with Centrifuge! During recreation, students play fun games, work together, and complete trust initiatives. All of these aspects of recreation are tied back to and related to the gospel and Bible study. Your students will be partaking in rec every day, led by their Bible Study Leader.</p>
<p>Rec Rally</p>	<p>Every day at the end of rec, students will gather to celebrate the fun that happened that day on the rec field as well as get excited for Bible study. Rec Rally is led by our Recreation Director who facilitates all things rec / rec rally and will hand out different spirit awards to Bible studies throughout the week!</p>
<p>Adult Gathering</p>	<p>Adult Gathering is a time for all group leaders and adult sponsors to meet with your camp Director and receive announcements and information for that day as well as be led in that day's Bible study. Adult Gathering is normally held while Centrifuge students are at recreation and while MFuge students are in Bible study.</p>
<p>Track Times</p>	<p>Track Times are a part of our Centrifuge programming. These are afternoon classes that are led by FUGE Camps staffers. They range from outdoor, sports classes to creative ones such as crafts to classroom tracks such as spiritual gifts. Your students will sign up for Track Times for the whole session of camp during registration on opening day.</p>
<p>Track Time Rally</p>	<p>Track Time Rally happens before every track time. During this time, track leaders will be holding signs designating what track they are leading, and your students will make their way to their designated track time. Adults are expected to be at Track Time Rally to help make sure all students get to where they need to be.</p>

Mega Relay	Mega Relay is exactly what it sounds like- a mega relay! This is an all-camp activity where students will participate with their Bible study group in this relay event. Adults are encouraged to come and cheer on their students as well as participate in our adult heat. Your point of contact for more questions will be your camp's Recreation Director.
Site Send Off	Site Send Off is specific to MFuge. Students and adults participating in MFuge will gather with their Ministry Track Leader as they get excited for all that God is going to do out at ministry sites!
Welcome Back	Welcome Back is what we like to call the time when MFuge participants return back to campus from their day of serving at their ministry site. You can expect FUGE Camps staff to be excited and goofy as they champion you for serving others all day.
Hang Time	Hang time is built into the camp schedule every day for you and your students to do just that- hang out! This is free time. During this time, there will be different tournaments going on that your students can choose to participate in if they would like. A lot of students and group leaders utilize this time to shop at our FUGE Camps Store. Our FUGE Camps Staffers like to use this time to hang out with your students as well!
Night Life	Night Life is an evening program element built into the schedule. It may be a worshipful time or a fun time.
Mission Offering	Each summer, FUGE Camps partners with the International Mission Board and North American Mission Board to support their work with certain projects. A mission offering is collected at camp during worship. Monies received go to these two agencies, as well as some of our community MFuge organizations that we partner with during the summer. Our Mission Mobilizers oversee this portion of the service. Your group will be given an envelope earlier in the week and that is where your group offering will go. Someone from your group will walk it up to the Missions Mobilizer during this time.

Church Group Time	Church Group Time happens every night following worship, where you get to spend some time with just your group. Group leaders will lead this time with their group however they please. FUGE Camps does provide a guide to follow, if you choose.
Church Group Host	A FUGE Camps staffer will be assigned to your group to serve as your point of contact during your session of camp. This person will contact you the week before you arrive at camp to help answer any questions you may have at that time. He will also be available to you during camp, will check in with you daily and walk your group to Church Group Time.
Director	Your camp Director is in charge of leading the FUGE Camps staff at your location and is in charge of the overall camp program. The Director will lead Adult Gathering.
Administrative Director (AD)	The Administrative Director (AD) is in charge of making sure your students are placed in Bible studies and track times and are accounted for. They are in charge of all other logistics that go into ensuring you and your students are taken care of at camp.
Site Director (SD)	The Site Director (SD) is in charge of MFuge at your camp location. The Site Director plans ministry sites and works with our Ministry Track Leaders to make sure we are serving the community to the best of our ability.
Financial Director (FD)	The Financial Director (FD) is in charge of the financial side of camp at your camp location. The Financial Director runs the camp store, completes financial forms, makes deposits and works with the location contact, as needed.
Recreation Director (RD)	The Recreation Director (RD) is in charge of recreation. She will set up, tear down, and lead rec rally every day. The Recreation Director is also your point of contact in regards to first aid.
Production Director (PD)	The Production Director (PD) is in charge of everything that takes place in the auditorium. This includes all programming elements.
Care Director (CD)	The Care Director provides care and support for

	<p>the staff team and assists with sick and injured staffers. The CD also ensures camper special requests are met and handles incident conversations when students share information of a crisis nature.</p>
Emcee	<p>The Emcee is the main person you see on stage hosting camp elements. The Emcee will run the instagram page for your camp location and will be your “hype person” for all things at camp!</p>
Mission Mobilizer	<p>The Mission Mobilizer is in charge of educating you and your students about our mission's emphasis for this summer at camp and will be your point of contact with regard to missions.</p>
Location Contact	<p>The location contact is who helps us with the logistics of running camp at their location. You may meet the location contact during your first Adult Gathering on opening night.</p>
